2. Renovation of Facilities

The boys' toilet was renovated with upgraded amenities to ensure hygiene, comfort, and a safe space for our students.

3. Technological Advancements

To foster 21st-century learning, smartboards have been installed in all classrooms, enabling interactive teaching.

4. Enhanced Classroom Facilities: Extra fans and lights were installed in all classrooms, creating a more comfortable learning environment.

5. Tiling and Water Purifier Installation: Four blocks have been equipped with tiles, and new 4 water purifiers have been installed to ensure clean drinking water for all.

6. Technology Upgrades: A new server was purchased to facilitate the efficient conduction of the SAFAL examination.

7. 5,000 square feet of **derris** were purchased to lay it on the Nikunj so that students can comfortably sit and watch the programmes.
