1. MISSION AND VISION

Al Aqsa Public School is dedicated to providing a transformative educational experience that balances modern technology with deep-rooted ethical values. As an institution with Affiliation Number 931110, we strive to nurture students who are intellectually curious, physically fit, and morally upright.

2. FACULTY EXCELLENCE AND DEVELOPMENT

Our academic success is driven by a professional team of **43 teachers**. Beyond their classroom duties, our educators participated in specialized training and competitions, including the Teacher's Kalotsav Practice and the Teacher's Fest, which included both on-stage and off-stage events.

3. INFRASTRUCTURE AND LEARNING SPACES

The school provides a superior learning environment through **36 well-appointed classrooms**. Our campus infrastructure is designed to support diverse needs, featuring a comprehensive **Library**, advanced **Science Laboratories**, and a specialized **Robotics Lab**.

4. ACADEMIC GOVERNANCE AND ASSESSMENT

The academic year follows a structured evaluation path, beginning with a formal Re-opening Ceremony.

- **Term Exams:** The curriculum is divided into Pre-midterm examinations and comprehensive Half-Yearly Examinations.
- **Post-Midterms:** Regular assessments continue into the second half of the year to track student progress.
- **Annual Exams:** The academic year concludes with the final Annual Examinations and a subsequent Open House Meeting.

5. SECONDARY SCHOOL MILESTONES (CLASS X)

We provide specialized focus for our Class X students to ensure board-exam readiness:

- **Periodic Testing:** Students undergo multiple rounds of periodic testing throughout the year.
- **Intensive Coaching:** A dedicated Xth Camp is held to provide intensive academic support.
- **Model Examinations:** Three distinct Model Exams are conducted to build confidence and refine exam techniques.

6. LEADERSHIP AND DEMOCRACY

To instill civic values and leadership qualities, the school conducts a School Parliament Election. This process culminates in a formal Investiture Ceremony, where the elected student leaders are officially commissioned into their roles.

7. PARENTAL ENGAGEMENT AND PTA

The school views parents as vital partners in the educational process. The year begins with the PTA General Body Election to establish leadership. Ongoing collaboration is maintained through CPTA meetings and the final Open House Meeting to discuss student development.

8. CELEBRATING ACADEMIC MERIT

Recognizing excellence is a core value at Al Aqsa. The school hosts dedicated Merit Days to honor students for their exceptional academic and co-curricular achievements, fostering a culture of appreciation and hard work.

9. INNOVATION IN TECHNOLOGY AND ARTS

The school emphasizes a blend of digital proficiency and creative expression:

- **Digital Fest:** A platform for students to showcase technological innovation.
- **Exhibitions:** Various events are held, including a general school Exhibition, Subject Skill Exhibitions for primary sections, and a specialized Craft and Arts Exhibition.

10. SPORTS AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Our physical education department organizes a wide array of competitions to ensure physical fitness:

- **Indoor Sports:** Tournaments in Caroms, Chess, and Skating are held to build focus and skill.
- **Athletics:** Major events include the TCS Athletic Meet and specialized Kids Sports Days.
- **Field & Martial Arts:** Students participate in house-wise Football tournaments, as well as Karate and Kabaddi competitions.

Students are encouraged to celebrate their cultural roots through various school-wide events:

- **Onam Celebration:** A vibrant traditional event followed by a scheduled holiday break.
- **Kerala Piravi:** Observed to honor the birth of the state and its heritage.

We focus on building responsible global citizens through various observances:

- **Sustainability:** Promoted through World Environment Day and Farmers Day celebrations.
