With very much pleasure students of Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan Valanchery took part in Badminton, Chess and Kho Kho in CBSE district sports and games under Malappuram Central Sahodaya. Badminton under 17 boys , under 17 girls and Under 14 girls secured first position, under 14 boys second position and Under 12 Girls third position.

Our students under 12 girls and under 17 boys secured I<sup>st</sup> position, in Kho Kho Championship under 14 boys and girls secured second position and under 12 boys third position.
