ANNUAL REPORT 2021 - 2022

Due to the pandemic situation that prevailed throughout the academic year, lessons were taught through online services. Teachers were given training in technology to equip themselves with the knowledge of online teaching. Classes were designed in such a way that there would be minimum clashes in the timings of classes. Sufficient instructions regarding the things and operational methods were intimated accordingly.

CBSE introduced special scheme of biannual board examination for the year 2021-22 to break the one-short nature of board examinations and also to possibly mitigate the impact of pandemic. For this purpose the curriculum was split into 2 terms. The Term 1 examinations were conducted smoothly in the month of Nov-Dec 2021. The term2 examinations will be held during the month of April- June 2022.

Regular classes started for class X and XII from November 2021 and later all the other classes were brought in batches for lessons. Online classes or videos were provided to those who could not join the offline classes held at school.

The great care and perseverance our faculty members show in both scholastic and co-scholastic activities are the prime reason for our students' success in the outside world, especially in the present turbulent scenario.

Let me say with utmost confidence that our students will continue to shine in life, successfully tackling the challenges life throws at them because of the structured learning as well as the moral teachings they receive from this institution.

We continue to maintain great academic records with top results both in 10th and 12th Standards this year too.

For this I thank God Almighty, our patron – the Catholicos and the Malankara metropolitan H.H. Baselios Marthoma Paulose II, our manager, H.G. Dr. Yuhanon Mar Diascoros, our bursar and local manager, beloved Mathukutty Achan, our principal, our former principals and our beloved teachers who are highly motivated and dedicated and have put in their best efforts to achieve the same.

We seek the intercession of our late lamented H.G. Geevarghese Mar Ivanios, former manager of our school, who led us both morally and spiritually and especially motivated our children to do charity work among the downtrodden.

The scholastic year started formally on 1st June 2021 after an online retreat for teachers by Rev. Fr. John Varghese. This class greatly inspired and motivated our teachers to run the academic race of 2021-22. As per the CBSE intimations, teachers in every department participated in their respective “capacity building” and “subject enrichment” programmes.

Let me record our achievements in the curricular and co-curricular field. We were

able to achieve a high quality result in all subjects. Due to covid pandemic situation CBSE board exams were canceled and accordingly developed a method to generate results based on the mean average scored by the school in the previous years and were calculated based on the academic performances of students during the academic year.. From Class XII Science stream, Don P Thomas and Ashna Anna Philips stood at the top by scoring 96.8%, from Commerce stream, Jyothilakshmi S and Malka Susan Zachariah secured the highest score with 96.8% and from the Humanities stream, Mahima Sara Chacko scored 96 % . In class 10 we secured 100% results with 13 students securing A1 grades in all subjects. 2 students scored 100% in social science.

The results of the other classes were equally praiseworthy, displaying quality and marked improvement, due to various steps implemented in the school like remedial teaching, counseling, etc.

Our students secured the overall championship trophy of MGOCSM KALAMELA 2021.

To inculcate cultural, literary and moral values and also to promote leadership qualities in children, various club activities like Maths club, music club, science club, cricket club, chess club, drawing club, eco-club, skating, karate, dance, yoga etc. are organized.

Our students participated in different competitions at schools and collegiate level and achieved high ranking results in all the items with overall championship too.

Our school was awarded 'A+' Grade for last year's Malayala Manorama's Nallapadam work. Mr.Aju Ninan Joseph, Dr. Rajesh Kadamanchira and Mrs. Bincy Andrews are the motivation behind this programme.
