## SAINIK SCHOOL DIVISION

The central government has chosen Dr. Raju Davis International school, Mala as one among the hundred schools in India for the establishment of a new Sainik School . These schools are being established in hundred selected districts across the country, with only one school in each district being granted permission after meeting high standards in academics, arts, sports, and physical facilities. The District Collector and Sainik School officials have conducted an inspection. The Sainik School, operating under the Sainik School Division of the Ministry of Defense, Government of India, will function separately alongside existing batches with CBSE affiliation. It will start with two batches of 40 students each for the 6th standard and will gradually add one class each year up to the 12th standard. The admission process will reserve 40% of the seats for students who qualify in the All India Sainik Schools Entrance Examination (AISSEE) at the national level, open to students from various states. The remaining 60% of the seats will be reserved for students studying in this school in the 5th standard who qualify in the same examination. The Central Government will provide a certain percentage of fees for 50% of the students in Sainik Schools. Upon completing the 12th standard, students will have easy entry into the National Defence Academy, opportunities for officer training in the Army, Navy, and Air Force, and preparation for the Combined Defence Services Examination. They will also have priority seats in Medical, Engineering, Commerce, Humanities, and MBA courses, as well as government and private sector opportunities. Students can choose to pursue these opportunities or opt for other paths after completing the 12th standard.

## Advanced Civil Service Foundation Course from Class VI onwards

Foundation Course to equip students to appear for Civil Service exams like IAS, IPS, etc... and for Central Government Class I officers selection tests (RBI officer, Income Tax officer, P F Commissioner, Insurance officer etc...) are conducted from class VI onwards. Training for MAT, CAT, NIFT, All India Engineering services, Tourism Management entrance exams are also included. The course is conducted in alliance with the famous IAS coaching centre.

Syllabus includes basic Numeric skill, Data interpretation, Mental ability, Decision making, Problem solving, logical reasoning, Analytical ability, Inter personal skill, Communication skill, comprehension, Current events etc. Only 40 seats are available and admission to this batch will be given only from the merit list of the Entrance test to be conducted on April 1<sup>st</sup> week.

**SCHOLARSHIPS FOR CLASS XI**

50 % of the Tuition Fees are given as Scholarship in Class XI for those who have received 95% mark and 25% discount for those who have received 90 % mark in class X public exam

**Scholarship for sports and arts:**

Outstanding performers who secure 1<sup>st</sup> place in district level will get 25% scholarship in individual items. In group items it is 15%.

For second and third winners will be entitled for 15% and 10% for individual items. Second and third for group item winners will be entitled for 12% and 10% respectively.

## HOSTEL

- ▶▶ Separate hostels are available for Boys and Girls. A/c dormitories are provided. Separate Study room and Cupboard Room / Dressing room are provided. Junior boys hostel is having 6-8 beds in A/c room and are equipped with attached toilets, fridge etc..
- ▶▶ Pink Cubicles - Girls of the higher grades are provided private cubicles with attached toilets and upscale amenities . Apart from double occupancy, cupboards and study tables, the cubicles are air conditioned and equipped with fridge and sofa. Both Hot and cold water is provided. An oven, hot and cold water dispenser, water purifier, induction cooker etc. are provided as common amenities. House keeping department will change the bed linens every week and laundry services are also provided.
- ▶▶ Tutors are arranged to take care of the academic progress of the students within the school itself.
- ▶▶ Heavy industrial washing unit is available to wash the hostel students' clothing without any extra cost.
