GENERAL RULES AND GUIDELINES FOR PARTICIPATING TEAMS

1. The CBSE Swimming Competition shall be conducted under the rules of the Swimming Federation of India (SFI), with modifications wherever applicable.
2. Every school will be entitled to enter only one swimmer in each of the following events:

IMPORTANT:

Events marked (*) will be conducted on time trial basis. It would mean that every swimmer in these events will get only one chance, and the final positions in these events will be determined on the basis of time recorded in different heats.

3. In under 11 years age group, a swimmer can participate in maximum three Individual events and in relays.
In under 14 years age group, a swimmer can participate in maximum four Individual events and in relays.
In under 17 & 19 years age group, a swimmer can participate in maximum five Individual events and in relays.

* The Individual Championship (Best Swimmer) in any age group will be awarded only to one swimmer on the basis of medals won, and in case of tie, performance will be taken into consideration.

4. From each Zone, the first and second position winners will qualify to participate in the Nationals.
5. At Zone level, in case there are less than four swimmers present for a particular event, it may be conducted and swimmers may be awarded the medals and the merit certificate. But they may not be awarded the points so as to be included for the Individual or Team Championship. However, the names of first and second position winning swimmers may be forwarded for participation in Nationals.
6. At National level, in case there are less than four swimmers present for a particular event, it may be conducted \ and swimmers may be awarded the medals and the merit certificate. But they may not be awarded the points so as to be included for the Individual or Team Championship.
7. No swimmer shall be permitted to participate without proper swimming costume.
8. The decision of the Referee on all technical aspects will be final.
9. In case of any protest, the decision of Jury of Appeal/Protest Committee shall be final
10. The championship will be decided separately in boys & girls section.
11. The points shall be awarded on the team basis according to the point systems as per the following criteria as adopted by SFL.

12. A separate prize may be given to the Individual Champion in Boys and Girls section, in all the age categories. For deciding the Individual Champion, the performance in the individual events and individual medley may be taken into consideration. In case of tie in points; two swimmers can be declared as joint Individual Champions.
13. A prize may be given to the school scoring total maximum points and may be declared as over-all Champion.
14. All the first three position winning swimmers shall be awarded with the Merit Certificate and the medal. However, only first and second position holders will participate in National event.
15. All the remaining participants shall be provided with a Participation Certificate.
16. In the case of relays, all the five members of the team (if five names are given before the meet in the eligibility Performa and all five have attended the meet) irrespective of who swims the finals, shall be awarded the Medals and Certificates
17. New Meet Record(s) wherever created should be clearly indicated as 'NMR'.
18. The school Organizing Zone level competition shall take a Group Photo of the teams that have qualified to participate at National level competition. The photo shall be signed by the host school Principal and forwarded to the school organizing next level of competition along with the original entry Performa.

GENERALGUIDELINES

1. Participating schools are requested to send their confirmation by email latest by 18th July 2026.
2. Teams are requested to inform the exact time of arrival to enable us to receive the teams at railway station, failure to which will lead to making of their own arrangements.
3. The organizing school will provide accommodation to the registered teams in the school campus.
4. No team will be allowed to participate without Team Manager/Coach.
5. Participants are requested not to bring valuable items such as jewelry, mobile, camera, iPods etc., as use of these items in the campus is at their own risk. Organizing school will not be responsible for the loss of it.
6. Teams have to report to the host school by 24th July 2026 as Boarding and Lodging will be available from 24th July 2026.
7. The participants must carry their Identity Cards at the time of the competition duly filled and signed by the Head of the Institution, valid for the current year. Participants of Class X / XII must carry IX / XI Class board registration cards respectively, XI Class students should carry their X Class mark sheet issued by CBSE and for other classes birth certificate issued by Municipal Corporation should be attached to ensure date of birth. All should be duly attested by the principal of the participating school with Unique ID no. given at online CBSE registration.
8. All the players should be within the particular age group as on December 31st.
9. For Under-11 Categories born on or after 01/01/2016 For Under-14 Categories born on or after 01/01/2013 For Under-17 Categories born on or after 01/01/2010 For Under-19 Categories born on or after 01/01/2008
10. Protest of any nature should reach to the Organizing Secretary and CBSE Observer in writing within 15 minutes of the declaration of the result. It should be accompanied by a fee of Rs.1000/- (Non-Refundable).
11. A Managers Meeting will be held on 24th July 2026.
12. Teams without online registration and proper eligibility forms will not be allowed to participate in the competition.
13. Consumption of non-vegetarian food, alcohol, tobacco chewing and smoking is strictly prohibited in the campus. Violators would be immediately asked to leave the premises/meet.
14. Team manager will be responsible for the conduct of team on and off the field. Indiscipline by a team member will lead to disqualification and the team member may be asked to leave the premises immediately. Lady Teacher is must to accompany the girls team.
15. The Organizers reserve the right to debar a participant/Team and Coach/Manager from the competition for unruly behavior/ interference in the smooth conduct of events.
16. An amount of Rs.500/-per day per person for the arrangements of the boarding, lodging & meals, should be paid to organizing school.
17. The participating schools will deposit payments against meals on full day basis and no part payment will be accepted. The participating schools must not insist for refund of part payment.

18. A security amount of Rs.5000/-(refundable) has to be deposited by each team on the date of reporting.
19. All the participating teams should carry their two school flags and other necessary kit, documents etc. as per the instructions of the CBSE.
20. The March past is compulsory for all the participating teams. They should be in their complete Sports Kit for the March past.
21. Team must report at least 20 minutes in advance in proper outfits & gear for the match.
22. You are advised to go through the CBSE Rules and Regulations 2026 related to the event.
23. Team members are not allowed to move around the school and in the school campus. All are expected to maintain decency and proper decorum.
24. Outsiders apart from escort teachers are not allowed to come in the school campus.
25. The school will not be responsible for any loops, illness or accident, which may occur during tournament.
26. The Team Managers and Coaches are supposed to stay with their teams.
27. The contingent should bring necessary clothing (according to the climatic condition of Bhopal) while mattresses, bed sheets & pillows will be provided by the school.
28. All participants are advised to carry their own mosquito repellants, Blankets, lock & key for safety.
29. The contingent must not cause damage to the Technocrats International School Property. In case of any damage the participating team will have to bear the cost.
30. The team officials are requested to complete all the formalities and clear all the payments before their departure. Certificates will only be provided after the NO-DUES clearance.
31. It is not obligatory on the part of organizing school to provide food/transport facility to school/teams making their own stay arrangements. Also, it is the responsibility of school/team staying outside to collect information in regard to matches/ fixtures/programs.
32. Every day last entry in the campus will be by 9.00 pm. After 9.00 pm no team members will be allowed to go out of the campus without permission.
33. The departing teams are requested to inform two hours prior from their departure to the Accounts Department for clearance of their accounts and for arranging the transport.

Accommodation Notice

As per CBSE guidelines, accommodation & food will be provided on campus at ₹ 500 per day per student. We are making every effort to provide comfortable classroom accommodation with bedding, as prescribed by CBSE. Schools opting for this facility will be only charged ₹500 per day per student. For those who prefer enhanced accommodation, additional options have been arranged at nominal charges. The accommodation is exclusively for participating students and team in-charges. As per CBSE guidelines, team in-charges are also required to pay for their accommodation and food.

1. Basic stay in classrooms in the campus as per CBSE norms	Rs 500/day (Bedding and food)
2. Non-AC dormitory with cot and bedding -2 km	Rs 150 Extra /day/person
3. Non-AC dormitory in a nearby school , 5 cots in a room and 7- 8 can be accommodated - 6 km	Rs 150 Extra /day/person
4. AC dormitory in the campus	Rs 200 Extra /day/person
5. AC cubicles with 1 bunk bed, divan & attached bathroom (3 students/room)	Rs 500 Extra /day/person
6. AC cubicles with 2 bunk beds & attached bathroom (4 students/room)	Rs 500 Extra /day/person

For participants staying outside the campus, school buses will be available in the morning and evening at a nominal charge of ₹50 per trip per student, subject to sufficient demand.

In the campus AC dormitory, we can accommodate nearly 300 students. We have arranged a few AC cubicles with 1 bunk bed in each room & attached bathroom in the campus. The room also has a divan sofa which can be used as an additional bed. There are only 13 cubicles and the

bookings can be done with a payment of Rs. 500 per day per person. We also have one AC cubicle with two bunk beds, one divan sofa, and an attached bathroom. The payment for this is Rs. 500 per day per person. In the two other Non-AC dormitories and triple rooms, we can accommodate nearly 500 students. This is near the school hostel. Some of the students have booked hotels for their accommodation. Hotel accommodations are available in Mala (full), Ashtamichira (4km), Annamanada (6 km), Kodungallur (11 km) Chalakudy (16 km), Irinjalakuda (16 km) and Nedumbassery-Athani (Airport proximity 20 km). If sufficient number of students are there from the destination, buses can be arranged on nominal payment. Remaining students can be accommodated in classrooms with bedding. As we are conducting boys and girls sections separately, we hope that the above accommodations will be sufficient.

A Google Form will be shared with the schools' Shiksha Mail Ids. Individual replies will not be entertained. Accommodation will be allotted on a first-come, first-served basis. Priority will be given to those who submit the Google Form first. The last date to submit the Google Form is 16th July 2026. After the submission deadline, the accommodation allotment list and payment details will be shared. The allotted amount must be paid in advance.

Mentioned below are Rule no 8.1.16 and 8.1.18 of CBSE guidelines regarding the payments for food and accommodation.

- Rule No 8.1.16 - All accommodation bookings are on a 24-hour basis. The schools will have to deposit payment against meals on a full day basis. No part payments will be collected
- Rule No 8.1.18 - The team returning after their respective matches shall be eligible for refund of payment deposited for meals and accommodation but only for the balance meals and coupons and accommodation from the next day onwards
