**REOPENING DAY
GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS**

- ❖ All students should reach the school before the first bell.
- ❖ The school uniform and identity card must be worn every day. A student without proper uniform will be sent back.
- ❖ No student shall be permitted to go home during school hours without a written request from the parent/guardian in the prescribed form and permission of the Principal.
- ❖ Students should wear modest dress on their birthday.
