Our History

It was a humble beginning in 1992, when a group of visionaries took up the daunting task of educating the local population to bring about their upliftment. It was this foresight that resulted in the submission of a project proposal for an English Medium School before Thaikkattukara Muslim Jama-ath. The Prototype of the plan was approved and a school managing committee was set up to monitor the school and raise adequate funds for the startup.



The Muslim Educational society was generous to lease out its Thaikattukara MES centre for three years. With Prof.T.O.Pareed Pillai as the Principal, Ideal Public School was inaugurated by then Kerala Educational Minister Jb.E.T.Muhamemd Basheer on 9th May 1993.

Scheme of Study

The school follows CBSE syllabus and prepares student for All India Secondary School Examination (Class X) and All India Senior School Certificate Examination (Class XII) conducted by C.B.S.E. Board New Delhi. The medium of instruction is English. Malayalam, Hindi and Arabic are the other languages taught. Religious instruction is taught to Muslim students. Moral Science lessons are given to Non Muslim students as supplementary subject.

Admission Procedure

Students desirous of seeking admission to any of the classes will have to fill in the application form available along with prospectus and submit in the school office on or before the due date.

For admission to L.K.G., a child should have completed the age of 4 at the time of admission.

For admission to Class I, a child should have completed the age of 6 at the time of admission.

Registration is no claim to the right to admission. Admission will be strictly subjected to the availability of seat. Supporting documents are to be produced at the time of admission.
