Staff Development

K P M School consists of well trained, experienced and dedicated teaching staff, administrative staff and supporting staff.

Infrastructure

We have upgraded our infrastructure facilities including our computer lab, Science labs and library. Currently we have a Physics lab, Chemistry lab, Biology lab and Computer lab. The construction of the third floor of the administrative block is nearing completion.

New Academic Year

The new academic year 2023-2024 began on June 5. Every year our enrolment has increased, and our family grows bigger.

Vidyarambham

Vidyarambham, the opening of the new school year was held in a grand style on 5th June 2023. All the lady teachers in their uniform sarees and gents teachers in their uniform shirts reported at school at 8:00 a.m. There were separate assembly for primary classes and senior classes. The new assistant Director, Rev. Fr. Tony VC was given a warm welcome on this day. The school band escorted the guests to the auditorium. The new students were welcomed with the accompaniment of shinkarimelam.

Staff Meeting and Subject Councils

Regular staff meetings are very important for the smooth functioning of a school. They are platforms to share, discuss and plan for the future. Staff meetings are conducted for the whole school and section-wise. Class-wise meetings and subject councils are also organized.

Examinations

Examinations are an essential part of the teaching learning process. Pre-Primary conducts their term examinations. I to VIII classes have two periodic tests, one half-yearly test and an annual examination. Classes X and XII have three term tests, one half-yearly examination and three model examinations.

Academic Achievements

Academic achievements reflect the diligence and skills to perform to the best of one's ability. The sincere efforts of the students in the CBSE Exams brought laurels to

the school. In the class XII Examination, our school attained 100% result with 15 distinctions and 9 first classes. Three students scored above 90% in all subjects. In the class X Board Examination also the school secured 100% result with 30 distinctions and 27 first classes. Four students attained hundred on hundred in Malayalam. Congratulations to all our high achievers.

Parent Teacher Association

PTA is a group of closely knit individuals who work together for the betterment of the students. Parents provide valuable feedback and suggestions to the teachers and teachers in return provide them with academic results and the changes made in school for improvement. Class-wise PTA meetings are held throughout the year.

School Parliament
