## GENERAL RULES

Education aims at "manifestation of perfection in man". It helps in "turning the inner eye towards light". True and better education means better citizens, and better citizens means better future for the country. For the achievements of these aims you are requested to observe & obey the following instructions.

### UNIFORM

- Girls with long hair should plait their hair. It is mandatory for girls to wear hair band in the school campus, inside the bus as well as outside the school campus while representing the school.
- Colouring, bleaching or highlighting the hair is not permitted.
- Boys are expected to have a proper hair cut. Dyeing of hair or using hair gel is not permitted.
- Shirt buttons should not be kept open and the shirt should be tucked in properly irrespective of the dress i.e., uniform or coloured dress.
- Ensure student's come well groomed in complete school uniform.
- Failure to follow the rules will result in suspension from school.

#### Girls (Std I - IV)

Uniform pinafore should be box pleated reaching 5 cm below the knee. Shirt should be half sleeve 1 inch above the elbow. Shirt should not be tight. The cloth badge should be stitched on the left hand side of the shirt. Black tights (shorts) must be worn.

## **Girls (Std VI - X, V-X)**

Over coat should cover the seat. The cloth badge should be stitched on the left hand side of the over coat.

## **Boys**

Shirt should be loose, full sleeve, with single pocket. The cloth badge should be stitched on the left pocket of the shirt. No low waste narrow bottom pants (14-15 inches bell). trousers are allowed in the school. Only formal pants with pleats are permitted.

### **Wednesday's uniform - house uniform**

## **Foot wear**

Students are permitted only to wear black sandak during rainy season. No other footwear is allowed in the school. All the students should wear black shoes with blue colour socks with yellow circles at the top on all days.

Students should be in full uniform with **ID Card, Polished Shoes** and neatly **ironed dress**.

Boys must cut their hair, short and girls must keep their hair neatly and duly tied with black bush (ponytail)

**Note : Badge, Belt, Tie and Socks are available in the school office**

## **SCHOOL CONVEYANCE**

School is providing conveyance facility by school bus to important localities on a reasonable fee. Parents are requested to use the same for the safety and security of their wards.

Students who are using the school bus facility should inform prior in writing to the office, any change in their bus boarding point. One month's notice to be given before discontinuing the use of the school vehicle in written to the office Students upto Std. V are not permitted to come to school on bicycles.

## **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS**

**Parents are expected to co-operate with school authorities by enforcing regularity and discipline. The greater the co-operation between the home and the school the surer and faster the child's progress in education.**

Withdrawal of children from classes during the school hours is not permitted. In case of emergency, a written request from the parent is necessary.

None other than the parent is allowed to take the ward from the school.

Once the child is entered the school will not be allowed to go out of the school at any reason. However the students living nearby the school, going home for lunch have to intimate in the school through school dairy.

Costly and fancy ornaments / items should not be worn / brought. Applying nail polish is not permitted.

Whitener should not be brought to school.

Students are not permitted to bring Mobile Phones, CDs, Cameras or Pen-Drive to the school. The confiscated property will not be returned.

## TO THE PUPILS

1. The School Time 9.10 am to 3.30 pm
2. All students must attend the morning assembly
3. **Speak only in English in the school campus and also in the school vehicle.**
4. Do your home work first and then allot time to play. Home exercise shall be done regularly and carefully. Submit at the appointed time.
5. **Don't miss your classes for attending all the social gatherings.**
6. Follow the instructions given by the school authorities in its true spirit.
7. Speak politely to the elders, try to greet them when you meet them for the first time on each day.
8. Don't quarrel with your classmates and other students.
9. Keep your class room and the school premises clean and tidy. Don't disfigure the walls or throw scraps here and there. **Use dust bins.**
10. **Don't bring any valuable item to the school including ornaments.**
11. Wear proper school uniform on all working days.
12. Personal hygiene and cleanliness are expected from all.
13. Child suffering from contagious diseases will not be allowed to attend the class
14. Don't loiter around during the class hours. Playing in class rooms and corridors is strictly prohibited.

15. While passing along the corridors during class hours be silent. No shouting or whistling is allowed in the class rooms. While moving along the corridors "KEEP LEFT".
16. Bring the Diary to the school on all working days and ensure that entries in it are upto date. Show your Diary to your parents.
17. Don't go out of the school campus during the working hours without the special permission of the Principal.
18. No pupil will be allowed to sit in the exam unless his / her fees have been paid.
19. Fees once paid will not be refunded.

### **TO THE PARENTS**

1. Send your ward to school neat and tidy on every working day in time.
2. Go through the school diary for any instruction given by the teachers. Attest the instruction given by school authorities.
3. Pay fee in time, otherwise the pupil will not be allowed to attend the class.
4. See that your ward speaks politely; observe his behaviour pattern.
5. Help your ward to do his home work and learn his lessons regularly. Identify his problems and intimate the same to the teacher concerned.
6. Dont go to the class room or wait nearby during working hours. In case of emergency principal's permission must be obtained.

7. The receipts issued by the school office towards the payment of school fees, bus fees etc. should be produced whenever asked for.

3. Do not use plastic wrappers, lunch box, water bottle etc.
4. Minimize the use of plastic bags.
5. Promote the use of eco-friendly items.

## **FEE**

## **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. Late comers must get signature of the parent / guardian and Principal in the appropriate columns in the Late Attendance Record in the pupil's diary, before entering the class room
2. If a pupil falls ill or becomes unable to attend the class during any working day he / she should get entries properly made in the leave record in diary and submit the same to the class teacher.
3. A student who has been absent for more than 7 consecutive working days is to submit a medical certificate.
4. The names of pupils who have been continuously absent for 15 working days and who have failed to apply for medical leave will be removed from the rolls. Such pupil may be re-admitted by the Principal if he/she is satisfied with the explanation offered by the parent / guardian and a re-admission fee Rs. 1000/- is to be paid along with outstanding dues if any.
5. Any kind of damage done to library books, laboratory equipments, furniture and fittings and other properties of school shall be made good off.

## **ADMISSION**

Students are admitted at the beginning of the academic year. Every candidate for admission must be introduced in person by parent or guardian. Those seeking admission for their wards should produce a copy of birth certificate / T.C.

## PROMOTION

Promotion to the next higher class will be based on the pupils achievement in the unit test, formative assessment, summative assessment and maintaining good conduct and character through out the year. Attendance during the tests / examination is compulsory. Those who absent themselves from tests/exams will not be re-examined for the said tests/exams.

### **A student must have 85% of attendance for promotion**

All matters regarding promotions depends on the discretion of the principal and her decision shall be final and binding.

## WITHDRAWALS

In case a child is to be withdrawn after the commencement of the academic year he / she will have to pay the entire fee for the rest of the academic year before T.C. is issued. Notice of withdrawals must be given in writing at least one month in advance.
