# PROSPECTUS

## RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE SCHOOL

### 1. AIMS of the School

#### *The School aims at:*

- @ all round development of the pupil.
- @ forming a new generation of people who are committed to task of building up a just society.
- @ emphasising corporate activity in character building, making each pupil mentally alert physically alive.
- @ fostering in the pupils a high degree of integrity, honesty justice and charity.

Your child is a precious treasure you have graciously received from God. Education of the child is the prime obligation of the Parents. So we believe that every parent must try to find sufficient time, irrespective of every heavy schedule, to take care of the child. Enable your child learn the lessons of love, kindness, faith, truth etc... from the lap of the mother and father. Do not entertain the impression that your child will learn these lessons from others. The school authorities and teachers can only extend a helping hand in order to fulfil your obligation. In order to secure all that is best in the education of children, the maximum co-operation and support of parents is desired.

## GENERAL RULES

1. Every pupil must bring the school hand book to the class daily.
2. All shall remain silent and study till the teacher comes to the class.
3. When the teacher enter the class room, the pupil should stand up, greet him/her and remain there till they are asked to sit.

4. Homework shall be done regularly.
5. The school premises should be kept neat and tidy.
6. It is compulsory to speak English in the school premises,
7. No mobile and electronic gadgets are permitted in the school campus.
8. Playing in classrooms and corridors is strictly prohibited.
9. When passing along corridors during class hours pupils shall keep silence.
10. No pupil shall enter any classroom than his/her own without the permission of the concerned teacher.
11. Never put waste things anywhere other than in the dustbin.
12. Pupils are not allowed to bring any other books or periodicals other than school books.
13. No post-ponement & pre-ponement of term examinations.
14. Running ,playing or shouting inside the school building is never allowed.
15. Nails must be kept short and clean. Nail polish, varnish or hardener is not allowed.
16. Girls are not allowed to put on facial makeup.
17. Girls are not allowed to put on lipstick, lip gloss, or any other cosmetics.
18. Tattoos are strictly not allowed on any part of the body. Students found with tattoos may be suspended until efforts are made to remove them permanently.
19. Hair must be kept neat and tidy at all times. Fancy hair styling, tinting, dyeing, highlighting and bleaching of hair are strictly not allowed for all students.
20. Boys must be neat in appearance and clean-shaven at all times. No facial hair is allowed.

21. School property is your own . Defacement of School property will be penalized
22. They are also not permitted to come to school by driving / riding vehicles except bicycles.

## **TO THE PARENTS**

1. Parents are expected to co-operative with the school by enforcing regularity, punctuality and discipline in the children and by taking sincere interest in their progress.
2. To see that their children prepare their lessons at home and devote at least one hour in the morning and two in the evening to study. Only if parents give their full co-operation, the school can help in the all round development of the child.
3. Parents should check the diary everyday and take note of the homework is done before the children are sent to school the next day.
4. Any communication (request / complaint) made by the parents should be addressed to the Principal.
5. Parents and Guardians are requested to see that their children come to school with their nails and hair properly cut and combed, trimmed as well as in neat school uniforms.
6. Parents should encourage their children to participate in the school activities.
7. Presences of the parent - Teacher meeting is compulsory. Primary School (LKG-1 Std) students, parents must meet the class teacher, with the permission from the principal, once a month to know the progress of the child. Failure to meet teachers is a serious lapse against to the child.

8. Parent should avoid planning social functions, tours and pilgrimages on school days.
9. Parents are welcome to meet the teachers on working days 3.30 p.m. to 4.00 p.m.
10. Parents should remit the school fees and term fees on the days prescribed, without delay.
11. A progress report shown the academic development of the children, with suggestion for improvement, will be sent after mid-term examination. The report must be signed by the parent/guardian and returned to the school within three days of issue. For the terminal examination, parents are expected to correct the same from the school in person.
12. The parents are always welcome to meet the school authorities and express their views and suggestions in a spirit of co-operation and good will.
13. Change of address of parents/guardians should be notified to the principal.
14. The school diary serves as a means of communication between the school and the parents. Please note and countersign the remarks entered in the diary by the teachers.
15. Parents are requested to retain the fee receipts till the end of the academic year.
16. We are much interested in your child as you are : so take us into confidence about everything relating to your child.
17. Parents / guardians need to seek admission to this school only if they agree to abide by these and other rules and regulations.
18. Parents may use the diary pages for brief communication with the school.

# DAMAGE TO THE SCHOOL PROPERTY

- Students are strictly forbidden to write a scribble on walls, desks, benches etc. or through paper or spill in around the classrooms or cause damage to the school property such as laboratory articles, library books, furniture etc.

## B. SCHOOL FEES

The rates of tuition fee and special fee will be fixed by the management. Parents are advised to remit fees at the beginning of each term. The tuition fees for the twelve months are payable in four equal instalment on the following dates without fine.

All fees are to be paid on the prescribed dates. Pupils shall not be allowed to write the examination unless all the dues are paid up-to date. Fees once paid are not refunded. Parents are requested to send the exact amount of fees with their children and to keep the fee receipts and to produce it as a proof of payment if needed.

## ***House System***

To make more effective management and a healthy competitive spirit, the school (I to X) has been divided into four house. Each house is distinguished from the others by a colour as follows.

1. Red House
2. Blue House
3. Green House
4. Yellow House

Each house has as its head a House Prefect who is assisted by Vice-Prefect. Every house strives towards the same goal, the development of the character together with a determination to keep discipline. Each individual, no matter to which house he/she belongs has an equal responsibility in the discharge of his/her duties. House meetings are held as and when necessary to plan for the Inter-House competitions if any.

## ***Discipline***

Strict regularly, obedience, politeness and courtesy in speech and conduct, smartness and cleanliness of dress and person are rigidly insisted upon.

Objectionable conduct, whether in or out of school is punishable with expulsion.

## ***Uniform***

Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday - Regular Uniform

## ***School Library***

Library books are issued for home reading, to every student Grade V onwards once in a fortnight. Damage or loss of these books will have to be made good in full by the pupils. The Librarian may call for the return of any books even before the expiry of due date. Reference books may not be taken out of the library. Borrowers are required to examine the books at the time of borrowing and report to the librarian any damage, loss of pages, pictures etc, noticed. Borrowers are not permitted to pass on the book to others. Books borrowed shall be kept neatly. Avoid marking, underlining or defacing the books.

## ***Hand Book***

Hand book must be brought to school daily and should be maintained carefully. Pupils should write down daily assignments in the students page provided and the parents must sign it every weekend.

The parents must check the hand book daily. The remarks given by the principal and the teachers must be signed by the parents.

## ***School Bus***

The school runs its own buses for the convenience of pupil. The charges vary according to the distances. Parents have to make necessary arrangements to hand over and to collect back their pupils at scheduled bus stop. If school authorities are unable to run the bus, parents have to make their own arrangements to the school. The school will not provide alternative transport facilities to students who miss the bus.

## ***Bus Rules***

- \* Queue System is to be strictly observed.
- \* The smaller children should be seated before senior student occupies the sitting space.
- \* Students should remove their bag from their shoulders before boarding the bus and keep it on the rack.

## ***Withdrawals***

No leaving Transfer Certificate is issued unless the parents make a requesting in writing. One month's notice of the withdrawals is required. No leaving certificate will be issued until all the fees and dues have been paid.
