Respected dignitaries, honoured guests, dear parents, teachers, and my beloved students,

With a deep sense of pride and gratitude, I present before you the **Annual Report of Sree Narayana Central School for the academic year 2025–26**, encapsulating the rich spectrum of academic, co-curricular, cultural, and value-based activities conducted during the year.

The school reopened for the academic year on **2nd June 2025**, welcoming students with renewed enthusiasm and a spirit of learning.

On **5th June**, **World Environment Day** was observed with great significance. The programme was inaugurated by **Sri Subash, Agricultural Officer, Bhoothakulam**. Students took an eco-pledge, released an Environment Magazine, planted saplings, and showcased their concern for nature through dance, poetry recitation, and PPT presentations.

The **La Masia Football Academy** was inaugurated on **12th June** by **Shri K Ajayan, Indian International Football Player**. On this occasion, a 5's Football Tournament fixture was organised, motivating students to pursue sports excellence.
