OUR SCHOOL

Sreenarayana Public School is a Co – Educational institution established and managed by Sree Narayana Vidyapeetam Charitable Trust, (Reg.No. 64/10/IV) Adimaly. The school follows C B S E Syllabus.

Our aim is to impart a sound education through a wide training which shall develop the character and personality of each pupil.

The school provides each child with the best education possible based on virtues and values of life. Our educational endeavors aim at forming leaders who are intellectually competent, spiritually mature, Morally upright, Psychologically integrated, physically healthy and socially acceptable, who will champion the cause of justice, love, truth, and peace and who are ever open to further growth. We aspire towards creating a just and human society where dignity of human being brighten and individual person is respected. It is our intention to create a world where unjust social structures are challenged, where our cultural heritage of 'Ahimsa', religious harmony and national integration is upheld, and where the poor and the marginalized are specially taken care of. To this end, a number of innovative features are being incorporated into the formal frame work of the curriculum of the School.

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

The school aims at the development of a wholesome personality through the emphasis given in the curriculum for physical growth. It is the objective of the school to train at good members of the society who are fit to perform justly, carefully and magnanimously all the offices of both private and public life. This training ensures the creation of the high sense of social awareness and responsibility enabling the students of this institution to grow into socially committed citizens of India.

CURRICULUM

The School provides highly efficient coaching to both boys and girls according to the syllabus prescribed by C B S E. The objectives of the curriculum is to achieve fully develop the student's individual potentialities rather than to confine him / her to books alone. The medium of instruction is English; Hindi and Malayalam will also be included in the curriculum. Periodic and monthly evaluation and parent / teacher meeting will help to assess the level of attainment of the student. CCE System of education is well established in the campus.

CO - CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

In order to gain the integration of education and cultural values with a true philosophy of life, the school provides ample opportunity for CCA through the literary Association, Science Club , Internet Club , Audio – Visual Theater, Sports ,Arts , Games , Organ, Tabala , Guitar, Drawing, Painting , Dance , Music , Roller Scatting , Yoga , Martial arts Crafts and Study tours .

THE ACADEMIC YEAR

The academic year starts in June and ends in March. All public holidays are holidays for the school. Termly holidays are given during Onam, Christmas and midsummer.

ADMISSION

Admission is granted to all children irrespective of class, caste or religion. Both boys and girls are admitted to the school following C B S E syllabus. Birth Certificate is compulsory at the time of admission. Application form will be issued on first come served basis and fees should be paid at the time of admission.

- ❖ Fees must be paid on scheduled dates.
- ❖ Pupils shall not be allowed to sit for examination unless all fees dues are paid up to date.
- ❖ Fees ones paid will not be refunded.

ADDITIONAL FACILITIES AVAILABLE

1. SCHOOL BUS :

School bus is available to all destinations. Details of the routes, timing, charges etc. are available at the school office.

2. COMPUTER COURSES :

Well – equipped computer lab and competent staff provide computer training for students from standard I. Computer Application is one of the optional subjects offered by the school for the C B S E course.

3. SCHOOL LIBRARY & INTERNET :

A very spacious library and reading room supplied with thousands of books and almost all journals in English and Malayalam can accommodate all students at a time.

4. ARTS AND SPORTS COMPETITION

The school provides opportunities to develop the arts and sports abilities.

5. SCIENCE LAB

The school has provided well established science lab with equipments and chemicals

6. MATHS LAB

The school has provided well established maths lab

EXAMINATION & PROMOTION

The school holds continuous and regular assessment and two term Examinations. We conduct two midterm assessments in a year, strictly as per the C B S E system for all classes and for promotion a student is assessed in scholastic and co – scholastic areas.

There will be open house programme after each exam. It is mandatory for all the parents to come personally and collect the progress report and put the signature.

HOUSE SYSTEM

To impart a healthy competitive spirit among students and to inculcate the habit of working together and to get training in leadership qualities; an efficient house system (4 houses) has been introduced in the school. Each house has a house animator to guide pupils.

LEAVE AND ABSENCE

- Previous sanction from the principal is needed for the absence of any student.
- Leave application should be given in the form prescribed in the diary.
- The name of those students who absent themselves without leave application for 15 consecutive days may be removed from the roll. Re admission is left to the sole discretion of the management.
- Students who are late in the school should bring the diary with reason recorded in it.

PICNICS AND TOURS

Picnic and Tours are part of study class activity and hence all are expected to join them. It will encourage and strengthen friendliness and love for each other. It is also a source of relaxation and help to develop knowledge, good relation and curiosity.

PARENT TEACHERS ASSOCIATION

All parents are members of the Parent – Teacher Association of the school. The annual subscription should be paid along with the first installment of Tuition Fee.

RECOMMENDATION TO THE PARENTS

In order to secure all that is best in the education of our children, maximum co-operation between parents / guardians and the school authorities is desired. Parents are expected to co-operate with the school authorities by enforcing regularity and discipline by seeing that the children prepare their lessons daily and by taking and helpful interesting the activities of the school.

Occasional visit to school and checking the notes and composition books of your wards are very useful to improve their studies. Parents should feel free to discuss with their children about their studies and life in the school.

Parents must keep the receipts issued to them and produce the same as proof of payment, if needed.

Parents are particularly expected to fill in the required data asked for, in the hand book, to sign the progress report, monthly report or any other similar documents when so requested. We recommend that parents should go through their children's hand book every day, to see the lessons and home works assigned for the next day, and they should also keep an eye on the Leave and Absence Record.

Criticism of the teachers of the school in the presence of your children should be avoided; because it may make them lose respect for their teachers. If you have a legitimate complaint; please contact principal as early as possible, anonymous letters are not welcome.

Practicing English Conversation at home is helpful to the students for following classes and improving their Spoken English.

Discouraging your children from participating in school functions is not advisable.

Parents are requested to meet the teachers at least once in a month.

PARENTS SHOULD ENSURE THAT:

Fees are paid on schedule dates and children attend school in the prescribed uniform with the required books

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- Each student must have a school diary which should be brought to the school daily. No student will be allowed to sit in the class without the school diary, text books and the necessary note books.
- Refinement of character, obedience, neatness in dress and punctuality are expected at all times.
- During the school hours no student is allowed to leave the school premises without the permission of the principal.
- The students have to be present in the school before the first bell.
- The students are responsible for their own property and the school will not be responsible for the loss of money, books, etc. the belongings of the students such as books, bags, umbrella etc.; should be properly labeled.
- The students are not allowed to bring razor blades or any sharp instruments to the school.
- No child suffering from any communicable diseases will be allowed to attend the school.
- Any damage done to the school property as to that of other students will have to be compensated
- No books, newspapers or periodicals other than school books should be brought in the class.
- English is the language of institution and pupils have to talk English in the classrooms, bus boarding points and in the campus except in the language classes.

- Parents are requested not to enter the classrooms or to speak to the class teachers during class hours without permission of the principal. Parents who seek information or who wish to make any complaints should meet the Principal and not the teacher.
- Attending exams are compulsory.
- Students who are not in proper school uniform will not be permitted to attend the class.
- Absence on the opening and closing days of a term or after special holidays like Onam, Christmas etc. will be punishable. In the case of sickness, the school authorities must be informed in time and a doctor's certificate to be produced.
- Pupils who have not paid the fees will not be permitted to sit in the class or to write examinations, students will not be called to answer telephone calls.
- Students are forbidden to write or scribble on the wall, to run about howling or shouting inside the school building. Parents will have to compensate for willful damage done to school property.
- Any student who fails twice in the same class will have to leave the school.
- Any sort of negative criticism of the school ought to be avoided by the parents especially in the presence of the students and in public places.
- The presence of the parents / guardians at the PTA General body is compulsory.
- Please do not harass your children, abuse or punish them when they fall short of your expectations in academic performance, try to encourage and instill confidence in them. Please try to examine if you are in any way responsible for the backwardness of your child.
- Please do not believe everything your children tell you about the teachers or the school. Children are very imaginative and they cook up stories to escape punishment.
- Students are not allowed to keep mobile phones in the school compound.

AMENDMENTS OF RULES

The Principal / Management has the right to introduce new rules , amend or change these rules and regulations in case of exigencies and in furtherance of the aims and objectives of the Managing Society of the school , as and when necessity arises.

DISCIPLINE

- ❖ The school insists on punctuality, regular attendance, good manners, cleanliness and devotion to study. Above all the student must be courteous to superiors and fellow students.
- ❖ Every student shall bring the text books required or the classes neatly covered and labelled. No book, newspapers or periodical other than school books may be brought to school.
- ❖ Every student is required to help to maintain the school premises clean and tidy. Waste paper and other waste materials should be disposed in the bins provided for the purpose. Defacing of walls, destruction of furniture, tampering with the plants in the garden etc.; will be severely dealt with.
- ❖ All assignments should be regularly done and submitted. Parents / guardians are requested to read the REMARK section of the school diary of their ward every day.
- ❖ Pupils are responsible for the safe custody of their books and other belongings. No valuable articles or money should be brought to school. Sharp instruments and tools are not allowed in the school premises.
- ❖ Students must move along the corridors and veranda in absolute silence, and in an orderly manner. While moving to classes or halls, they have to keep right and move in a line.

- ❖ Students who remain in their class rooms during intervals are not allowed to play inside .They are not allowed to play in the corridors or in the school yards during intervals.
- ❖ In the absence of a teacher, it is the class leader's responsibility to keep order in the class. Strict silence should be observed inside the class during such times.
- ❖ Students are expected to converse in English while they are in the school campus, school bus, and in bus stops.
- ❖ Students are not allowed to leave the school premises during school time without the written permission of the Class teacher, Principal. They should never have any contact with the strangers on their way to or back from school.
- ❖ If any student is found sick or wounded, the matter should be immediately reported to any of the teachers for immediate attention.
- ❖ All students are expected to strictly follow the instructions given by the class teacher.
- ❖ Students travelling by school buses should queue up when they board the buses

LIBRARY: RULES AND REGULATIONS

- All the staff and students are directed to avail themselves of the library facilities in the school.
- Students may borrow only one book at a time may retain it for a week and it can be renewed for one more week. The librarian may call for a book at any time from the borrower.
- Examine the book while borrowing and report to the librarian of any damage, missing pages etc. before leaving the library.
- Books borrowed from the library should be kept neat. No marking, underlining or scribbling of any kind in the library book is allowed.
- The person in whose name the library card is issued will be held responsible for all books drawn

- A fine of Rs5 per day will be charged for late returning of books.
- If books are lost, damaged or defaced, a fine up to the cost of the book will be charged. In the case of any dispute the Principal's decision shall be final and binding.
- Reference books shall not take out of the library. No other books are allowed in the reference section.
- All library books and cards must be returned before the end of February every year .Clearance from the library is required before applying for Transfer Certificate.
- Strict discipline and silence should be maintained in the Library.

GOOD BEHAVIOUR

2. Be neat and modest in your dress and manners.
3. Courtesy biggest courtesy. Use the word 'please' and 'thank you' as often as needed.

GENERAL INFORMATION AND SUGGESTIONS

The school is committed to provide the best coaching possible to all students irrespective of the standards or courses. The parents are advised to encourage their children to make the best use of the class room coaching. Create a pleasant atmosphere at home and try to instill confidence in the children even when they do not perform to your expectation.

Please do not overburden them with unnecessary tuitions. Meet the teachers of your children as often as directed. Please do not form prejudiced opinions about the teachers from what your children tell you. Try to establish a good relationship with the teachers. We attach great importance to discipline and formation of character. Kindly remember that the major role in this matter is to be played by the parents.
