GENERAL INFORMATION

ATTENDANCE

A student must have put in a minimum of 85% of attendance for promotion to the higher class. Shortage of 15% can be condoned by the Principal on medical grounds. Shortage beyond this limit will not be condoned.

LEAVE OF ABSENCE

Any absence must be explained in the form of a leave note on the page provided for this purpose in the Diary and it must be signed by the parent and should be countersigned by the Principal. Pupils who absent themselves from the school without permission for more than 15 consecutive working days will be removed from the rolls.

PROGRESS REPORT

Progress report will be prepared immediately after the 1st and 2nd terminal examinations. Parents can come and sign it on any working day as intimated by the class teacher. Students should ensure that the progress report issued to them is acknowledged and returned to the school within 3 days.

ADMISSION AND WITHDRAWAL

1. Admissions are made strictly on the basis of merit after conducting entrance test and interview of the candidate.
2. At the time of admission the following particulars are to be furnished.
 - a. Copy of Birth certificate and Aadhar
 - b. Mark record
3. The fee once paid will not be refunded even if the pupil, for any reasons, opts to leave the school immediately
4. No child younger than five or older than seven is admitted to class 1.
5. The school authority reserves the right to refuse admission to a pupil without assigning any reason. They also reserve the right to dismiss students whose diligence of progress in studies is constantly unsatisfactory or whose parents show least interest in the progress of their children.

After 10th, Fees has to be paid with a fine of Rs. 10/- per day.

PAYMENT OF FEES

1. Each student has to pay one-year fee towards establishment, examination, sports etc. along with the first term tuition fees in the first month of every academic year.
2. The management is vested with and absolutely has the right of revising the fees whenever required.

EXAMINATION AND PROMOTION

1. The school conducts the tests, terminal and annual examinations. The parents can come and see the Reports only on the dates given.
2. Pupil, who absent from the examinations except for given reason, will be considered as having failed in the examination concerned.
3. Promotion shall be made to the next higher class based on pupil's total performance as assessed by periodical tests and final examinations. It is therefore very essential that students appear in all examinations. The minimum marks required for a promotion is 40% in each subject.
4. Annual examination marks will be entered into the Progress Report .No re-examination will be conducted in any subject. The results once declared are final and cannot be reconsidered.
5. Perfect order and discipline should be maintained during examinations

ONLINE FEE PAYMENT

Steps to be followed

1. Click on 'Fees payment' in the school website
