Sub: Extension of Provisional Affiliation to the above said school beyond 31.03.2016 – reg.

Sir/Madam,

This is with reference to your online application No. EX-02079-1617 executed on 29.06.2015 on the above subject. In this connection, I am directed to convey the sanction for regularization of extension of provisional affiliation of the school with the Board for its **Secondary School Examination** for a further period of five years w.e.f. 01.04.2016 to 31.03.2021 subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-

1. The School is required to follow syllabi and course as per scheme of studies prescribed by the Board for the respective Examination.
2. The School is required to abide itself by the Examination/Affiliation-Bye-Laws of the Board.
3. The School is required to apply on online for further extension of affiliation alongwith the requisite fee and other documents by 30th June of the preceding year in which the Provisional Affiliation expires. Applications will be accepted after the last date along with the prescribed fee and late fee Rs. 10,000 per month subject to Maximum of Rs.50,000/-.
4. Provisional Affiliation granted to a school will remain valid on receipt of online application of a school for further extension of provisional affiliation subject to the final decision of the Board.(Amended Rule 15.11)
5. The school will enroll students proportionate to the facilities available in the school as prescribed in the Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board which shall not in general exceed the optimum number as under from Pre-Primary to Class X :-

	Campus area	Enrolment	No. of Sections (pre-primary to X)
(a)	1.0 acre	1250	02 in each class
(b)	1.5 acre	1875	03 in each class
(c)	2.0 acre	2500	04 in each class

- (d) School running on bigger campus of more than 02 acres, the number of students shall be restricted as per the actual facilities in the school which shall be proportionate to the optimum number mentioned at (a), (b) and (c) above.
- (e) Schools running on less than 01 acre campus shall restrict number of students as follows:-

(i)	Secondary School	2000 sq. mtrs	600 upto Class X
(ii)	Sr. Secondary School with two streams	3000 sq. mtrs	900 upto Class XII

6. The school will strictly adhere with all rules regarding safety of students including Fire fighting, Drinking water, Sanitation, Transportation, etc.
7. Income & Expenditure and audited annual accounts statement duly certified by the Chartered Accountant for the current year is required to be sent and the same be submitted every year.
8. **Other conditions are contained in Annexure 'A' which is enclosed herewith.**
9. **Special conditions to be complied within 30 days:-**
 - a. The Extension of Provisional Affiliation up to Secondary level w.e.f. 01/04/2016 to 31/03/2021 has been granted provisionally subject to the conditions that the school will pay the pay scale and allowances which should at least be at par with corresponding categories of teachers employed in government institutions of the State Govt. or as per scale prescribed in 6th Central Pay Commission of Govt. of India in respect of its teachers and will make payment by the school through ECS mode.
 - b. The School Managing Committee has not been constituted as per norms; therefore, it may be re-constituted by including 02 representatives each of teachers, parents and CBSE nominee. Therefore, the school is required to forward 5-6 names of principals of the nearby CBSE affiliated school (2-3 of them may be from KVs/JNVs) for approval 02 of them as Board's nominees in school Managing committee.
 - c. The school is required to appoint more trained and qualified TGTs to maintain section-teacher ratio as per norms and furnish a fresh staff statement accordingly.
 - d. The school is also required to furnish valid **Sanitary Conditions, Drinking Water and Fire Safety Certificates** issued by the competent authorities.
 - e. The school is required to enrich school library by adding more books as per norms.
 - f. The school is required to furnish an **affidavit** in original sworn in before the first class magistrate to the effect that the school is not **sponsoring** candidates of any other school/Board in the Board examination.

Provisions of Affiliation bye laws for adherence:-

1. Fees should normally be charged under the heads prescribed by the Department of Education of the State/U.T. for schools of different categories. **No capitation fee or voluntary donations** for gaining admission in the school or for any other purpose should be charged / collected in the name of the school and the school should not subject the child or his or her parents or guardians to any screening procedure i.a.w. rule no. 11.1, 2 & 3.
2. The school should not use the activities for **commercialization:-**
 - a) **As per rule no. 19.1 (ii)** It shall ensure that the school is run as a community service and not as a business and that commercialization does not take place in the school in any shape whatsoever.
 - b) **As per rule no. 19.1 (ii)a** Any franchisee school making payment on account of use of name, motto and logo of franchiser institution or any other non-academic activities would be termed as commercialization of institution and to provide an affidavit that the school/society has not entered into any such contract to use Name, logo, motto for consideration of fee.
3. Teachers are to be made educated regarding **corporal punishment** & should avoid any type of such involvement i.a.w. rule no. 44.1 (d & e).
4. School will not prepare any student/ start class for **any other Board** except CBSE from their CBSE affiliated school building/ premises.
5. **Admission to the school** is to be made restricted under rule 6.1 of Examination bye laws and rule 12 (i, ii & iii) of Affiliation bye laws.
6. The school has to constitute a committee for protection of woman from **sexual harassment** at the work place and to abide by the guidelines and norms prescribed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in W.P. Criminal No.666-70 of 1992 Vishaska and other State of Rajasthan and other delivered on 13.8.1997 mentioned under rule no. 10.9.
7. Each school affiliated/ to be affiliated with the Board shall frame **Service Rules** for its employees which will be as per Education Act of the state/U.T., if the Act makes adoption of the same obligatory, otherwise as per Service Rules given in Affiliation Bye Laws. Further, **Service contract** will be entered with each employee as per the provisions in the Education Act of the state/ U.T., or as given in Appendix III, if not obligatory as per the State Education Act.
8. **Pay and allowances** to staff should be revised time to time to bring it at par with that to State Government. Further, **Salary and service conditions** of staff should be provided i.a.w. rule no. 3.3 (v) and rule no. 10.2 as appended below:-
 - a. The school in India must pay salaries and admissible allowances to the staff not less than the corresponding categories of employees in the State Government schools or as per scales etc. prescribed by the Government of India." Further, the service conditions as per Rule 10 and Rules 24 to 49 of Affiliation Bye-Laws also be adhered to.
 - b. Salary should be paid through Electronic Clearing Service (ECS) from the date of first appointment of the teachers on probation.
