### POINTS TO REMEMBER

Dear Parents,

- Mobiles and gadgets are not permitted in the school campus for the students
- Children who are sick and under any medication should not be sent to school on those days.
- Girls should avoid wearing gold and fancy jewellery and no hanging earrings will be entertained and school is not responsible for any loss.
- All students are expected to wear neat and full uniform prescribed by the school. Uniform and inner wears should be changed daily. (girls should wear black tights)
- It is mandatory to check the diary and other books of your ward regularly and signed. Kindly refer the rules and regulations mentioned in the diary. Leave should be marked in the space provided in the diary.
- Do not stuff your ward's lunch box to avoid wastage of food. A serviette should be sent along with lunch. (Table Napkin)
- Proper toilet training should be given to your ward.
- All the required note books and text books should be kept in the bag according to the time table given.
- Books must be wrapped with transparent or brown wrappers and properly labelled.
- All the belongings of your ward should be labelled including pencils, erasers, rulers etc.
- Two sharpened pencils and an eraser should be provided to your child every day. Kindly avoid Sharpeners.
- The personal profile in the diary should be duly filled and signed by the parent.
- Children should report at the school on time.
- The school diary and rough book should be brought to school every day.
- Parents should see that their ward completes the work assigned and learn their daily lessons.
- No medicines should be brought to the school or class without the consent of the class teacher
- Parents and students are requested to follow these rules strictly.
