Ahyan:

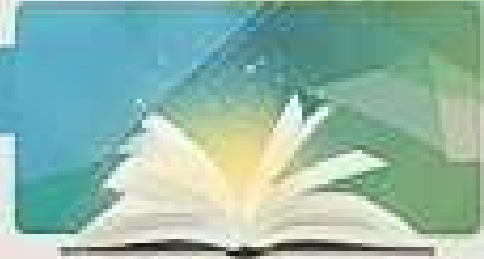
I want to be like Steve Jobs — curious, creative, and determined. I hope to bring new ideas to life, make a positive impact, and inspire others to keep learning.

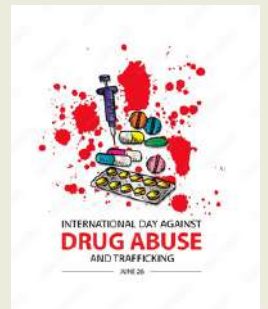

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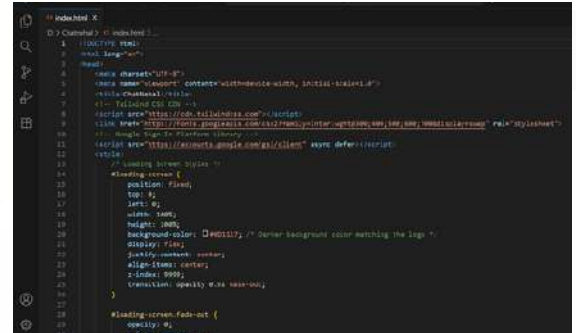

For quick or private interactions, you can use the temporary chat option.



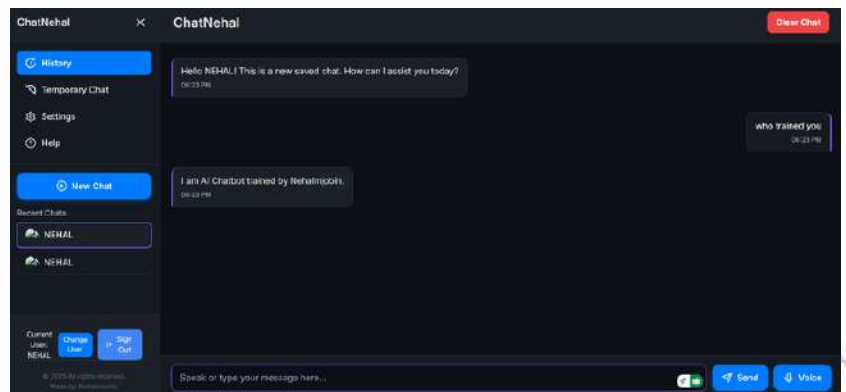

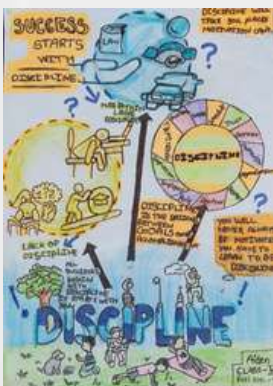

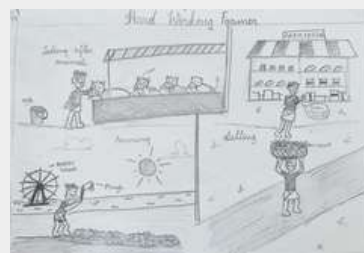
