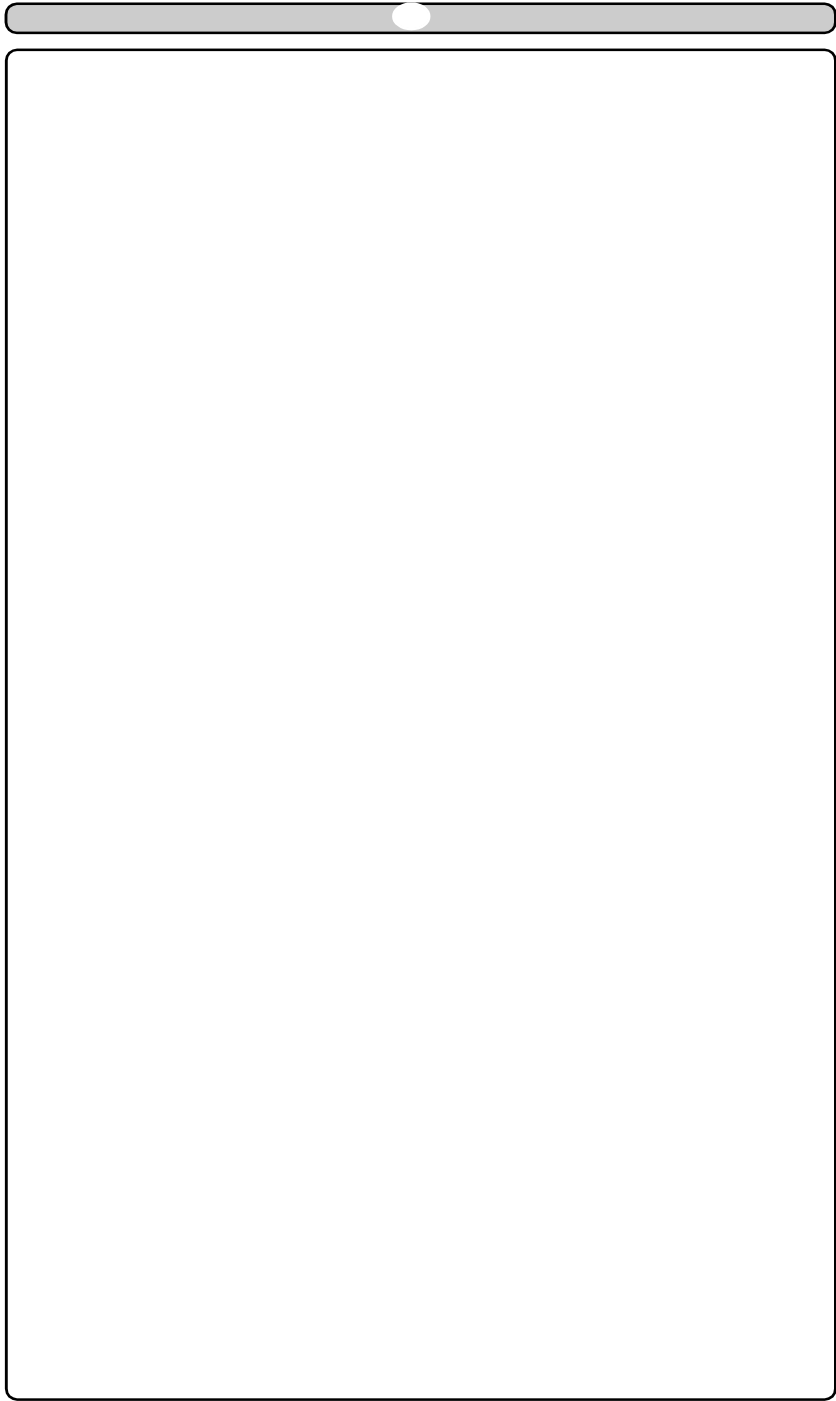

PREAMBLE

CHAPTER IV A

ARTICLES 51 A

Fundamental Duties - It shall be the duty of every citizen of India

The zero period activities for Tuesday and Thursday are the hallmark of the school. The class is divided into teams and activities like Thought for the Day, Recitation in English & Hindi, News Reading, Quiz, Extempore Speech are conducted to equip the children with more confidence, general awareness and power of expression in English. It will also help them to do away with stage phobia and ensure a pleasing personality. Zero period activities are supervised / guided by the respective Class Teachers. The Saturday Zero Period is exclusively for Mass PT [Std I-X].

C. HOUSE SYSTEM

The entire school is divided into 4 Houses. The various competitions and activities are articulated in such a way to bring out the hidden talents of all children. Once a child is inducted into a particular House, he/she will continue in the same House till Std. XII. **The House activities are as important as in leading Public Schools. The minute aspects are well taken care of.**

INFORMATION TO PARENTS

- ✧ Parents are advised to take special interest in the academic progress of their ward by spending time with them and helping them in their studies.
- ✧ Absence of their ward from classes without legitimate reason should not be encouraged. However, they should by no means send their child to school if he / she is indisposed.
- ✧ The rules of the school obligate parents to meet the Principal / Vice Principal / Class Teacher in the event of their being requested to do so.
- ✧ Parents should not allow their wards to carry valuable items to school or wear costly ornaments.
- ✧ Parents shall ensure that their wards come to school properly dressed in their uniform. Students shall be modest in their appearance.
 Wearing ornaments, fancy items, expensive watches etc are discouraged. Boys shall have a decent hair-cut. Long hair is not permitted. Girls are required to wear their hair in two braids. Short hair can be worn in two pig tails. Plain white hair band is to be worn by girls having very short hair. Girls are not permitted to wear flowers or coloured clips on their hair. Nail polish or jewellery (chain, bangles, anklets) is not permitted.
- ✧ Parents must ensure that their wards wear vest / slips and proper inner wear.
- ✧ Parents shall ensure that the snacks/lunch their wards carry to school are clean and in handy tiffin box with a napkin. The tiffin box and other personal belongings like water bottle, umbrella and school bag should have the name, class and roll number of the child written on them.

- ✧ Parents shall ensure that their wards attend / participate in programmes / events organized at the school.
- ✧ Parents are advised to pay school fee sufficiently in advance and thus avoid unnecessary embarrassment to their wards.
- ✧ Parents are to acknowledge and return Progress Report / Achievement Record and other circulars within 3 days of its receipt.
- ✧ Parents are forbidden to meet students or teachers during class hours and not allowed to telephone during class time.
- ✧ If the pupil is asked to attend any remedial classes the parents are to bring him/her to school.
- ✧ If any urgent message is to be conveyed, kindly intimate the school office.
- ✧ When a student is chosen to represent the school in any activity, the parents are to bring them to school at the stipulated time.
- ✧ **Any holiday declared by the Govt. or Dist. Collector will be a holiday for the School unless informed by the school authorities.**
- ✧ **Parents can meet the Class / Subject Teachers after the school hours, ie. between 3:30pm to 4:30pm.**

Parents (Father & Mother) must attend Parents - Teachers Interactions (only thrice in the year) for the interest of your children.

Admissions in KG ie Pre-school cannot be treated as an assurance of admission to Std. I

DISCIPLINE AND GENERAL RULES

1. While moving out of class, the student should go silently in a single file keeping to the right of the corridors.
2. Students of one class should not enter other class.
3. The school has beautiful class rooms and furniture. Students must understand that defacing or not keeping it neat will affect themselves. We will always try to use corrective measures, but as a last resort, heavy fines will be imposed. School office is out of bounds for children. Permission is allowed only for official work.
4. Irregular attendance, truancy, insubordination to teachers, habitual neglect of studies, obscenity in word or act are sufficient reasons for suspension or withdrawal.
5. No pupil suffering from contagious or infectious disease will be allowed to attend the school.
6. The school is not responsible for the loss of personal belongings of students. They should not bring valuable and costly items to the school.
7. Snacks and drinks should be brought in unbreakable containers. A turkey towel (12 cm x 12 cm) and a spoon must be brought.
8. Rubber slippers are not permitted in the school.
9. Students can wear coloured dress on their birthday.
10. No pupil will be promoted unless she/he attains 85% attendance; condoned only on medical grounds on Principal's discretion.
11. Teasing in any form against colleagues will constitute serious offence and, if repeated, may result in the expulsion of the offender from the school.

12. Copying or using unfair means in examinations will mean severe disciplinary action as per school rules.
13. No fund raising or collection for any purpose may be done in the school.
14. **Use of mobile phones by students is strictly prohibited in the school premises. Under no circumstances shall students bring mobile phones to school.**
15. Students are strictly warned against consumption of drugs and alcoholic liquor or tobacco in the campus.
16. Students are warned against using (audio / video CD's) cameras and other electronic devices without permission. They shall also not indulge in computer games of any kind during school hours.
17. Campus language and medium of instruction being English, students as well as teachers are to communicate in English inside the class, in the school premises and in the school bus.
18. Bringing objectionable books, pamphlets, pictures, magazines or material that might be detrimental to educational ethics shall be treated as offence.
19. Students shall not cause damage or destroy school property. If they do so they shall be liable to make good the damage along with fine as decided by the Principal.
20. Unnecessary running around and shouting in the school campus is not allowed.
21. Students are expected to reflect an exemplary behavioural act as **ROLE MODELS** to the rest of the Society. They should respect,

pay regards, greet seniors, school appointees, teachers and staff. They should get rid of their inflated ego to enhance their personality.

22. Students are not permitted to borrow, lend money or exchange any article.
23. Change of address is to be intimated to the school within a week. (Any delay or loss due to non availability of change in address will be borne by the individual concerned).
24. Students are to come in proper uniform. Faded, torn and unpressed uniform are unacceptable to the School. Parents are to ensure that the uniform is properly stitched, washed and ironed. Shoes are to be polished daily.
25. Excursions, Educational Trips/Study tours, Adventure camps etc. organised by the school are compulsory for the boys and girls.

WITHDRAWAL RULES

1. The Principal acting on behalf of Management, reserves the right of asking for the withdrawal of any student for whose correction, the ordinary means are in his judgement found ineffectual. Persistent offences against honesty, use of derogatory / bad language, and unsociability will expose the offender to immediate withdrawal. In such cases, the Principal doesn't bind himself to give reason for the action he has taken.
2. Parents or Guardians who persistently disobey the school rules or who are constantly over demanding in attitude or who are invariably critical in their dealings with the school authorities or members of the staff will be deemed as un-co-operative. In the absence of the possibility of a viable working relationship with them, to the advantage of their children, the Principal has the right to demand the withdrawal of the latter (child).

3. Any child who fails to conform to the accepted traditional and conventional standards of lady-like or gentlemanliness in conduct, deportment, exposes himself/herself to the danger of immediate and compulsory withdrawal from the school.
4. When parents are called to the School Office by the Principal / Teachers to discuss aspects of their ward's academic performance or general behaviour, they must assume that the reasons for such a call are of considerable importance or urgency. Unless their co-operation is immediate and whole hearted, they shall be obliged to withdraw their children from the school.

TRANSPORTATION RULES & REGULATIONS:

- Parents are responsible for the safety of the child by crossing the road to reach the bus stop / home.
- All Students availing the bus facility are expected to be on the right side of the bus stop 5 minutes before the arrival of the school bus. The bus will not wait for the late comers.
- The students should stay away from the main road until the bus arrives.
- No student should come near the entry door of the bus until the bus is brought to a complete stop.
- All students must occupy vacant seats immediately after boarding the bus.
- It is the student's responsibility to make sure that all his/her properties are collected before getting out of the bus.
- The drivers are authorized to stop buses at the designated stop only unless otherwise directed by the care taker of the bus.
- When the bus is in motion students must not move around in the bus and they must refrain from putting out their

hands or peep out through the window.

- Shrieking, shouting and unruly behaviour are strictly prohibited.
- Driver's attention must not be distracted for any reason.
- Parents are requested to advise their wards to adhere to the instructions given by the caretaker in the bus.
- Any act of indiscipline will be seriously viewed and reoccurrence of such behavior will constrain the school to discontinue the facility for the student involved.
- Parents should inform the school office when there is a change in location or route or if the child is absent.

VESTED POWER

Acting on behalf of the Managing committee, the Principal is empowered to waive any of the rules in this Almanac/Prospectus without assigning any reason for his action.

MANAGERIAL POWER

The interpretation of any rule in this Almanac / Prospectus, as well as any amendment to it, rests solely and entirely with the Managing Committee of the School. Their interpretation shall be final and binding on Parents/Guardians and no case shall lie in Court of Law in respect of their decision.
