
Along with it, they are empowered and supported by the Non Teaching and Support Staff. Their coordination with each other is what enables the school to function smoothly and grow with new perspectives.

In COVID-19 lockdown situation our teachers offered their relentless work to provide online study material and telephonic doubt clearing class can't be forgotten


Teachers spoke with parents and students to know the reason for not being a part of online class.



Teachers sent lesson based videos, PDF files of Class works and activities and updated the child.

Christmas was celebrated in advance on 22nd of December with all its importance. A family carol song competition and Pappa competition was organized.



- Family mega quiz and family photo shoot was organized for the teachers.
